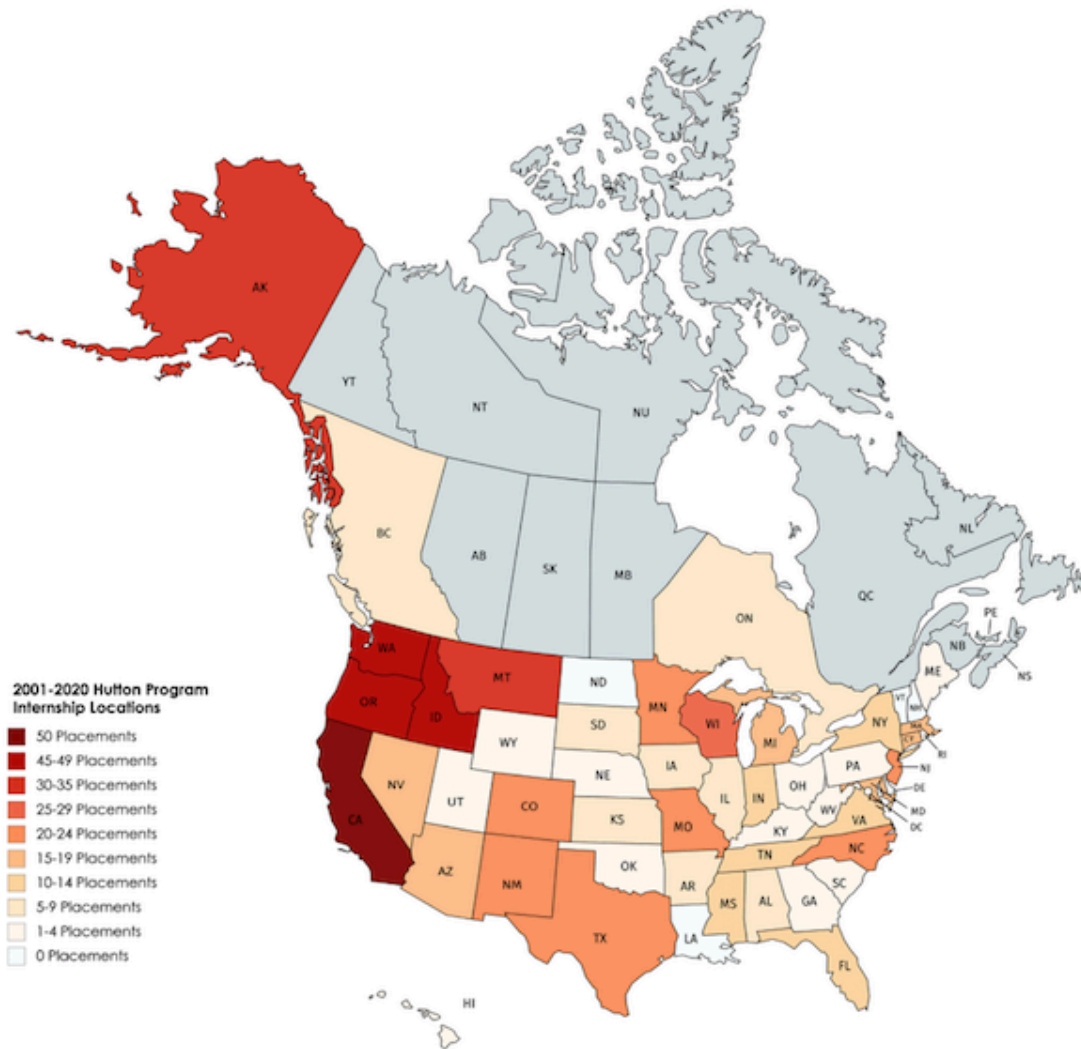


Figure 1: This map shows the density of Hutton Program internships from 2001-2020. Please note that Puerto Rico and Mexico placements are not listed on this map.
